

## OUT OF STATE STUDENTS

Please be aware that students living in North Carolina for less than one year have an out of state residency status as a student. This mean your tuition will be considerably more than the in-state rates most often quoted. The charges not covered by the awarded grant or scholarship will be billed to the student for payment. It is the student's responsibility to understand the charges incurred and make arrangements to pay the remaining balance after grants/scholarships have been applied. If a student can not pay the additional charges, he/she should withdraw before classes begin to avoid tuition charges on the account.
